## Mass Intentions

Every time we celebrate Mass, it can be offered for a particular intention. It can be offered for someone who has died for example, but also as a prayer for anyone who is still alive, either for their health and wellbeing in times of sickness and distress, or just because they are in need of prayers in a difficult time, or for any reason at all, as a birthday gift for example. As well as individuals, Mass can be offered for particular groups of people too, or for causes. If you wish to have a Mass said for someone you know who needs your prayers, or for someone who has died, or for a group of people or cause then do feel free to contact the Parish Office and they will help you with the process (the intention does not have to be printed in the newsletter if you wish to keep it private). It is traditional to make a small offering when requesting a Mass (£5 / £10 / £15 or so) but this is not obligatory so if you cannot afford it, please do not be put off requesting Mass for a particular intention close to your heart.
